Straight 8s

Drum notation for measures 25-32. Measures 25-28 are straight 8s. Measure 29 is the first ending, consisting of a diamond symbol, a quarter note, an eighth note, a quarter note, and a quarter rest. Measure 30 is the second ending, consisting of a quarter note, an eighth note, a quarter note, and a quarter rest. Measures 31-32 are straight 8s. A repeat sign is placed at the end of measure 32.
